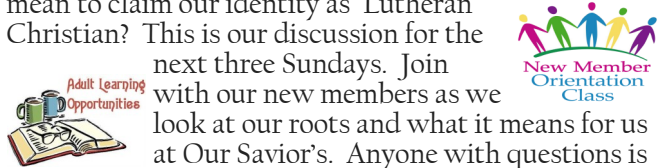
Restrooms are located past the nursery, near the library. Our ushers will be glad to point you in the proper direction.
