For visitors—please complete the visitor card in your pew and place it in the offering plate. These will help us to get to know you better. Thanks!



Pastor Tim's Summer Sermon Series—This summer Pastor Tim is preaching a sermon series based on the Small Catechism by Martin Luther. Each week, he will look at questions that you have raised in conversations regarding faith and life. In many ways these topics are as relevant as ever some 500 years after Luther addressed them in Germany. How can we begin to understand our faith, not in competition with the world around us, but rather as a foundation for all of the things we do and believe, and the decisions we make.

Our Father. God in Heaven Above—Music this weekend includes three organ settings by J. S. Bach of another hymn by Martin Luther, this hymn a versification of the Lord's Prayer. Unique to Luther's paraphrase is that almost every one of the nine stanzas is catechetical in form, with first a literal statement of the petition, and second, an explanation and application. The hymn is found in its entirety as #747 in ELW with a condensed version as #746. Bach's large setting, which serves as the prelude, is intricate and rife with meaning and symbolism. A smaller setting, during the offering, is a simple, quiet meditation.
