**Blessing of the Quilts—September 7 & 8**

The quilts being blessed today will funnel through Lutheran World Relief to people in need around the world. War, drought, and natural disasters have created a wide community of millions of displaced persons. Since implementation of the quilt tracking system three years ago, OSLC quilts have specifically been identified as being distributed to Angola, Burkina Faso and Tanzania (Africa), Georgia (Asia) and Haiti. To those forced from home and country, a warm blanket is a sign of hope. Additionally, a number of quilts will be given locally through elementary school social workers for children in need of warmth and comfort.

Over this past year, OSLC quilters have assembled 250 quilts to be sent on their way to LWR. We give thanks for the 10-15 ladies who gather each Wednesday morning to perform this mission. They welcome anyone who would like to join them. We would also like to thank those who assist in transporting the quilts to the train depot.
